- 1. I am 65 years of age.
- I am a former employee of the Department of Family Services, [herein referred to as the 2. department].
- I commenced working for the department in the capacity of a youth worker at the John 3. Oxley Youth Centre, [herein referred to as JOYC]. I started working at JOYC sometime in 1990.
- When I started employment at JOYC, either Barry Collins or Ian McIntyre was the 4. manager of JOYC. My work partners back then were youth workers Wayne Armstrong and Fred Feige.
- I remember the following staff working at JOYC. Sabina Konicanin youth worker, 5. Rodney Reston - youth worker, Gary Truloff - youth worker, Col Bray - senior youth worker, Paul Hamson - youth worker, Mariana Pearce - youth worker, Lorraine Hayward - senior youth worker, Eileen Bisby - senior youth worker, Trevor Cox - senior youth worker, Ouida Ratapau - youth worker, Mark Mills - youth worker, Damien Butler youth worker, Simon Nance - youth worker, Warren Christensen - youth worker. recall there were a few indigenous youth workers who started sometime after me. These were Carmel Belford – youth worker, Margaret Huer – youth worker and Paul Paulson – youth worker. I had no involvement in the Heiner Inquiry. I have not provided a written submission or statement to any person or Inquiry about my employment at JOYC.

- 6. Peter Coyne was the manager of JOYC before I started work at JOYC. I knew he was the manager because other staff had told me.
- 7. I don't think I was a member of a union when I was working at JOYC. I recall there was some tension by staff working at JOYC. This tension mainly related to the fact that management were not listening to staff concerns.
- 8. I was made aware by other staff and some of the residents about an Inquiry that was conducted at JOYC. I had no involvement in this Inquiry as it occurred before I started working at JOYC. I remember being told by some staff that this Inquiry was about the children being handcuffed outside. I can't remember who told me this.
- 9. I did not witness any incidents of sexual abuse at JOYC. As such I did not report any incidents of sexual abuse and nor have I submitted anything in writing to management or anyone else about any concerns of sexual abuse at JOYC.
