I, Gradus 'Archie' Cornelous OLDE-WOLBERS state;

- 1 am a 60 year old disability pensioner currently residing at an address known to 1. Police.
- 2. I am a former employee of the Department of Families [herein referred to as the Department].
- I commenced employment with the department sometime maybe around 1977. I 3. started work as a youth worker at the Sir Leslie Wilson Youth Centre. Janice Doyle was my manager there. I stayed at the centre for approximately 10 years before I was transferred by Janice to the newly opened John Oxley Youth Centre [JOYC]. I worked at JOYC for approximately 5 years as a youth worker. I remember during this time the manager was Peter Coyne. After 5 years I was transferred back to Sir Leslie Wilson at the request of Janice Doyle to train the younger youth workers. I remained at Sir Leslie Wilson Youth Centre for a further two years after which time I suffered from a nervous breakdown. I was then diagnosed with medical conditions and have not been able to work since.

- 4. During my time at JOYC I remember Peer Coyne being a good manager. Peter let me set up different programs for the children like camping and fishing. I would best explain my memories of working at JOYC as a pleasure and cannot recall there ever being any problems. The children were good with me.
- At no time whilst working at JOYC do I remember ever making any sort of complaint about the management of the centre. I do not remember being a union member either.
- 6. At no time did I ever see or hear of any sexual abuse allegations or concerns at JOYC or the Sir Leslie Wilson Youth Centre. I never even heard staff speaking of any concerns third hand either.
- 7. I didn't know that there was an Inquiry in relation to JOYC. I do not know of what the Heiner Inquiry means and do not know a Noel Heiner.
- 8. Staff I remember working with me at JOYC included fellow youth workers 'Connie', Fred Feige, Chris Edwards (deceased), Daryl Hood, Di Fields, Brad Parfitt, Lorraine Hayward, Eileen Bisby and Bruce Cassidy.
- 9. On the 13th November 2012 Detectives Parer and Mison attended my home during which time I provided them with my knowledge of this matter.
