I, Maurice Crothers state;

- 1. I am 48 years of age.
- 2. I am a Principal Advisor with Offender Rehabilitation, Queensland Corrective Services.
- 3. I am a former employee of the Department of Family Services, [herein referred to as the department].
- 4. I started working for the department in about 1986 at the Warilda Receiving and Assessment Centre. Warilda was a facility for processing wards of the state. I was employed at Warilda as a senior youth worker.
- In January 1989, I went through a department redeployment activity, due to Warilda closing down. I was placed as a youth worker at the John Oxley Youth Centre, [herein referred to as JOYC].
- 6. When I started duties at JOYC, Peter Coyne was the manager. I remember some other staff working at JOYC including: Trevor Cox, Brad Parfitt, Irene Colmer and Fred Feige.

- 7. I remember on my first day at JOYC I met with the manager Peter Coyne. On this first day, Peter Coyne told me that some staff at JOYC thought that his approach to running the centre was a bit strange.
- 8. Whilst I was working at JOYC, I was a member of the Queensland State Services Union.
- When I was working at JOYC, I was aware some of the staff were disgruntled. I don't
 know exactly what the staff were unhappy about. Being new to JOYC I stayed out of
 these staffing issues.
- 10. The first time I had heard about the Heiner Inquiry, was when I read the paper a couple of days ago. I have not attend any inquiry, nor have I provided any statement or submission to any investigation or inquiry about JOYC. I have also not provided my union with any statement or report about my time at JOYC.
- 11. I am not aware of any child sexual abuse at JOYC.

12. In total, I only worked at JOYC for about 4 months. I know I definitely left JOYC before the June 1989. I left JOYC because I thought there was little prospect of me being appointed to a permanent position. I remember one day I noticed my name was not on the roster for one particular month. As a result, I contacted my departmental human resources caseworker and sought a transfer. I subsequently obtained a further departmental redeployment activity whereby I was transferred to the youth unit. The youth unit helps locates homeless youth on the streets.
