I, Reverend Peter Wayne Palmer state;

- 1. I am 50 years of age. I am a priest of the Anglican faith in the Diocese of Willochra in South Australia.
- 2. I hold the Advanced Diploma of Theology and the Advanced Diploma of Counselling.
- 3. I am a former employee of the Department of Family Services, [herein referred to as the department].
- 4. I commenced working for the department at the Sir Leslie Wilson Youth centre at Wilson in about 1985. After about eight months at Wilson, I transferred to the John Oxley Youth Centre, [herein referred to as JOYC]. I started working at JOYC as a youth worker the day JOYC opened on the 1st of March in 1986. I specifically recall this date as it was my birthday.
- 5. Prior to working for the department, I was a volunteer foster carer with my wife. My wife and I took kids who came out of the Sir Leslie wilson centre and assisted with assessments for long term care.

- 7. When I commenced duty at JOYC, Terry McDermott was the manager. Terry was a great manager. I felt he led us youth workers as opposed to having to just manage us.
- 8. Peter Coyne became the next manager. To me it seemed that after Terry had left and Peter took over the centre lost its focus. When Peter Coyne became manager there was also a change in the residents at the centre. JOYC got a lot of residents from Westbrook which altered the dynamics at JOYC. These residents I would describe as being more "hardened" and staff were not trained to deal with these types of residents as we were youth workers not wardens.
- 9. I remember around this time I got knocked out by a resident. All I knew is that I woke up in the Ipswich Hospital. Everything started to go downhill. Staff got edgy and jumpy at work. In my opinion it was the case that the staff didn't have the skills to do the job.

Terry McDermott, the centre model had been about developing children as appose. to being punitive.

- A lot of staff resigned and left JOYC due to the management and staffing tensions under 11. Peter Coyne's management. I also resigned and left JOYC in about December 1988. I remember I commenced studies at Bible College in March 1989 after which I graduated and became a missionary in Arnham Land and then a priest in charge at Wyndham. .
- I have heard of the Heiner Inquiry. I was not involved in the Inquiry and as such I did not 12. give evidence nor provide any written material to the Inquiry. The Inquiry happened after I left JOYC.
- I did not witness any incidents of sexual abuse at JOYC. I did not report any incidents of 13. sexual abuse at JOYC.
