Issues for Consideration at John Oxley Youth Centre

I refer to our discussion concerning issues to be addressed at the John Oxley Youth Centre.

In my view the following issues (in priority order) could be examined.

- Clarification of grievance procedures to staff at all levels. 1.
- Resolution of personnel issues referred over a period of time to Head 2. Office for decision. In the main these relate to Sabina Konicanin, Marietta Pearce, Lorraine MacGregor and Danny Lannen.
- Staff training both initial and long term. 3.
- Staff safety issues. 4.
 - Operationalisation of an effective alarm system;
 - Inadequate seclusion facilities which has an effect on child management;

 - Structural problems e.g. steep stairs, inadequate lighting in the staff car park.
- Re-establishment of management authority. 5.
