I was asked to examine Annette on 27th May 1988 on the request
of the Juvenile Aid Bureau.

On examination Annette was fully pubertal with adult female genitalia.
There was no evidence of trauma. Bimanual and speculum examination
were normal. Cervical swab cultures were negative and cervical
smear showed normal endometrial cells but no endocervical cells as
she was menstruating at the time. I am not aware of the forensic
swab results.

Superficially, Annette appeared unperturbed by events. She has not had
adequate contraceptive advice to date.
