MEMORANDUM TO: Acting Director-General

SUBJECT: John Oxley Youth Centre
Discontinued Inquiry and Other Matters

Concerning the discontinued inquiry, the following things seem to me to need attention so that the matter may be concluded.

1. Final replies to -

- (a) Rose, Berry and Jensen, Solicitors for Mr P. Coyne and [REDACTED]
- (b) Queensland Teachers Union, on behalf of [REDACTED]
- (c) Professional Officers' Association, on behalf of Mr P. Coyne and [REDACTED]

A letter has been prepared to the Crown Solicitor to prepare these replies.

2. Final advice to the State Service Union which wrote on behalf of its members. There are some issues to be resolved regarding this in that letters of grievance from staff were provided to Mr Pettigrew and if they are retained they will have to be shown to Mr Coyne, but they were not initially provided on that basis.

In the same letter referred to in (1) above, the Crown Solicitor will be briefed to consider this question further.

3. Reply to letter of 8th December, 1989 from [REDACTED]

This may not now be necessary, given that [REDACTED] Union subsequently wrote on [REDACTED] behalf and is to be written to.

4. Clarification to all staff of grievance procedures. That Personnel were to meet with staff for this purpose was announced by you during the meeting at the Centre on 13th February, 1990.

5. Final advice to Mr Heiner

A simple letter could be prepared, unless you want the Crown Solicitor to do this.


