I advise that Mr Heiner was lawfully appointed to carry out the task he undertook.


As you would know the investigation he was conducting was terminated. Mr Heiner was not required to provide any report on that investigation and will not be asked to do so.

Specifically, apart from a copy of a one page document given to Mr Coyne by Mr Heiner's office, there is none of the abovementioned class of documents on any file or record of my Department which relates to Mr Coyne and nothing at all that relates to Mrs Dutney.

As the matter appears to me, neither Mr Coyne nor Mrs Dutney have suffered any injustice or detriment affecting their careers in any way.
