## I, Norma Alice Jones state;

- I was appointed as a Senior Policy Advisor for Minister Anne Warner in about January 1990, after the December elections. I was responsible for managing the office and providing the Minster with support and advice.
- 2. Within the Minister's office telephone calls were received by administration personnel who would then put the call through to the appropriate office or area for attention.
- In 1990, I knew Kevin Lindeberg. I probably had met Kevin, I don't recall, but I knew Kevin to be an organiser for the Professional Officer's Association (POA).
- 4. Early into my appointment, I believe it was January, Kevin came to the Minister's office in person and demanded to speak to the Minister. My recollection is that the Minister was in a meeting with other people at that time and was simply not available to see Kevin.
- He seemed quite agitated and insisted on talking with the Minister right there and then. I
  advised him that any meeting with the Minister had to be made through the POA formal
  process.

6. The Minister didn't have time to meet with every single person. We wanted the

respective Unions to be across meetings with the Minister and not just individuals. It was

about putting a process in place now that Ms Warner was the Minster. He seemed to be

irritated by this advice but left.

7. I was subsequently advised by administration staff that the Minister's office was

receiving a number of telephone calls from Kevin. I advised office staff to give Kevin the

same advice I had given him, in that, any meeting with the Minister had to be made

through the POA formal process.

8. I do not specially recall speaking to Kevin on the telephone myself, but I may have. I do

not recall March 8, 1990 or any particular day around that time. I am certain however

that I have never had a conversation with Kevin regarding the Heiner documents or the

documents being destroyed.

9. I have never had a conversation with the Minister, Anne Warner, to organise to provide

any such advice to Kevin and I have never provided any such advice to Kevin as a result.
